9th Grade Admission Requirements Students currently attending Public/Private Middle Schools

Policy: Prospective students who wish to apply to Immaculata-La Salle High School are invited to visit the school during Open House. Preference is given to students who are siblings of current students, alumni, and/or children of alumni. All students must be in good standing with his/her previous school. Prospective students may not have any disciplinary problems at his/her previous school.

Requirements: All students applying to Immaculata-La Salle should be fluent in verbal and written English. Immaculata-La Salle does not offer English as a Second Language (ESOL) or special education programs.

To be completed by the required deadline:

1. Complete online Entrance Exam application.
2. Pay online application fee for Entrance Exam.
3. Upload a copy of the student's social security card (if the student does not have a social security card a copy of the student's passport or birth certificate may be uploaded) to the online application
4. Signed Release of Records Form (submitted to ILS by mail, e-mail, or fax).
5. Print and forward English and Math teacher recommendation forms to the applicant's current English and Math teachers. The teachers are to mail, e-mail, or fax these recommendation forms directly to the attention of the Admissions Director at Immaculata-La Salle High School.
6. If applicable – if the applicant is currently receiving extended time or any other accommodation a current and complete psycho-educational evaluation must be submitted. The psycho-educational report must be from a licensed psychologist administered and within the last 12 months. In addition, if the student has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP), a copy is also requested to be submitted for their file.

In addition to the entrance exam scores, supplemental academic records will be required to complete the admission process in a timely manner. If applying after the deadline the parent/guardian must request:

7. A cumulative transcript from his/her current school. The transcript **MUST** INCLUDE:
 - 6th and 7th grade final grades
 - 8th grade – 1st semester report card
 - Standardized Tests Scores for 6th, 7th and 8th grades (ITBS, SAT, etc)
8. If applicant is a practicing Catholic, a letter from the parish indicating he/she is an active participating parishioner.

Please be advised that **Immaculata-La Salle High School will request this information directly from Public/Private school if application is submitted by the deadline.**

Admission decisions will take place throughout the month of January for all students whose files are complete. If deemed necessary, an interview may be requested before a final decision is made. If an interview is required you will be notified ahead of time. Please be aware that all interviews will be scheduled during school hours and proof of attendance will be provided to the student to turn in to his/her current school.

Acceptance/Rejection letters will be mailed in late January. Early decisions or notifications are not permitted per the Archdiocese of Miami, Department of Schools.

Registration will take place the week following the mailing of the admissions' decisions. Placement exam details will be included in the admissions package.
